Format

- Single space after periods
- Single space between lines
- Indent each paragraph with three spaces
- Length for story 500 words
- Justify copy

Components

Please suggest up to three possible titles for your headline as well as a subhead for the headline.

Underneath the story please list "callout quotes" – important parts of the story that the designer can place between your words.

Photography
